Staff and Students

Our school is blessed with 1100 students (LKG – Std X). All are given individual care and encouragement by 40 teachers and 7 non teaching staff. The day begins with a special prayer for the staff which helps us to dedicate our service to our children and to make them aware of modern trends. Limitations live only in our mind but if we use our talents and skills our boundaries become unlimited. The results of our students of Std X in all these years reflect the outcome of such hard labour. Last year we had cent percent result with full distinction in the CBSE Examination, Kumari Aneeta Cici George and Kumari Amrutha A got A⁺ for all subjects . In order to felicitate these winners Award Day was celebrated on 7th June. Sr. Graceline Jose our school manager and Vicar Provincial was the chief guest.

The school elections were conducted in the month of June 2012. Master Sebastian Tom and Kumari Adithya Y Suku of Std X were elected as the school leaders. Mrs. Princymol M was elected as staff secretary.

Teach Next

Our school is equipped with teach next facilities to empower teachers with technology right inside the class rooms. The programme enables to use digital resources in addition to the chalk and talk method of teaching in their day today teaching life. This result in a completely new multisensory learning experience for students and helps them to improve their academic performance and makes learning an enjoyable experience. It also improves teacher's effectiveness and productivity.

Communicative English

We have classes for Communicative English from (LKG – Std X) , to improve the conversational language skills of the students . The classes are handled by communicative English faculties. The students make an effective use of the programme.

Co – curricular Activities

Co – curricular activities improve manners and behaviour and make responsible and kind individuals. To develop the inborn talents of our students all Tuesdays are set a part for co – curricular activities . Experienced teachers give training in various fields of Dance , Music , Art & Craft , Yoga , Karate , Band and Musical instruments. Participation in Club activities mould them physically and mentally . Different clubs like Literary club , Science club , Maths club , Social Science club , Nature club , Quiz club etc are monitored intensively. We also conducted exhibitions for Science , Maths , Social Science and work experience.

Social Service Club

Our School Management provides fee concession to 20 students. We also have a Social Service club to lend a helping hand to the needy. The club was started to create awareness among children about the difficulties faced by the poor in the society and the need for sharing to ease their troubles. Every Friday a collection is taken from the students. As usual our students went to Kunnamthanam to celebrate Xmas with them.

Moral and Religious Activities

KCSL is an organization of Catholic students which works to spread the word of God and to strengthen the belief among students which is actively functioning here. In order to inculcate human values and spiritual discipline, the religion and moral science classes and counseling sessions are included in the curriculum. I take this opportunity to thank Sr. Jess Mary for giving counseling to our high school students. There is Holy Mass and confession for the Catholic students. We are very much grateful to our Vicar Rev. Fr. John Manakunnel and Asst. Vicars Fr. Johnson and Fr. Lijo for their valuable services. They always guide our students both morally and spiritually.

Forgoing the cares of exams and studies the students spend 2 days in recollection. Our KCSL Director Rev. Fr. Mathew Varuvelil and his team conducted the retreat for the Catholic students. 2 days camp on personality development was conducted for the students of Std VI – X under the leadership of Ratna Sagar publications.

Festivals and Celebrations

The art festival of this year was conducted on July 25th and 26th. Lively competitions prompted the students to put up the best performances. The winners of the school level competitions were chosen to take part in the CBSE Kalostavam at Chingavanam.

Children's day was celebrated on 14th November . Competitions were conducted for the students of nursery section . Students of LKG and L P section presented cultural programmes in the meeting. Mother Anitta was the chief guest . She distributed the prizes for the winners.

Christmas , the birth of Jesus Christ was celebrated with great pomp. Rev. Fr. Jacob Cheeramvelil (Vicar St. Joseph's church Chennamkary) was the chief guest . In his Xmas message he urged the students that love, unselfishness , prayer and obedience to God help one to discover the truth and destroy evil .

Festivals and National holidays like Independence day , Onam , Teacher's day , Patron's Day etc were celebrated.

Kripa Thomas Std VIII and Gowri M Nair Std VII won the 2nd rank for English and Malayalam respectively. In Greenquest scholarship exam Emi Antony Std II won the 3rd rank in the state level.
